- sites that are active in current domains but also took part in COVID domains of the study that are no longer open, sites will be advised that the COVID portion of their ISF can be archived.
- ISF sections for any further strata/domains of the study that become closed over time.

For dormant sites, only the site agreement would be active, which R&D also retains a copy of. A new ISF would be created if the site became active again with all relevant documents for existing study domains at site.
