CELEBRATING 10 YEARS OF REMAP-CAP!



This year marks the 10th anniversary of the REMAP-CAP trial, a study that has transformed critical care research with its adaptive platform design. Over the past decade, REMAP-CAP has advanced treatment strategies for severe pneumonia, including COVID-19 and influenza, with over 300 centers worldwide and 14,000 patients enrolled.

We thank all researchers, healthcare professionals, and participants for their contributions and look forward to continued advancements!




Study Tools

- After viewing, patients can sign a consent form to confirm they have watched the video. Additionally, patients should still be provided with a full copy of the PIS for their records.



Delegation & Training Logs

When filling out delegation and training logs, please ensure that you:

1. Include your site name, site number, and the full names of all staff members to ensure accurate documentation.
2. Follow GCP guidelines by dating, initialing, and explaining (if necessary) any changes or corrections. This applies to both written and electronic updates, and it's important that these changes do not obscure the original entry.



Interventions Immune Modulation

- **Baricitinib** can be ordered for severe patients through the usual hospital process and used immediately.
- **Tocilizumab** from Roche will be ordered when available; it may require study accountability.

Baloxavir

- Roche have informed us that Baloxavir will be available to order from the **12th August**.
- For Baloxavir labels we are using previous commercial stock for now.

Immunoglobulin

The NHSBT team is set to pilot plasma soon. Due to national blood shortages, some steps are delayed as resources are redirected.

We plan to expect plasma by September.



Associate PI Scheme process

- To register please complete the online Associate PI Scheme Registration Form on the [NIHR website](#).
- You will then receive a welcome pack with a checklist of activities to complete under the supervision of your local PI.
- The activities must be completed and the checklist has been signed off by your local PI mentor. Candidates must have recruited to the study or been involved in recruitment.
- We require your GCP certificate, CV, training logs and delegation log and completed API checklist from them.



The current domains open to flu patients are:


- Corticosteroid
