Funding extension

- Current funding runs until end November 2025.
- We're submitting a 13-month NIHR extension (Dec 2025–Dec 2026) by end August and will update all sites as needed.
- REMAP-CAP is a perpetual study with ongoing funding and no planned recruitment end date.

Coming soon

AM43 & Protocol 4.0

We will soon submit AM43, which includes the updated **Protocol V4.0**.

Once all approvals are in place and the protocol is ready, we'll notify all sites by email.

AM43 also includes:

- updated SmPCs, DSA's and PIS-ICFs
- PedsQL

Training

Ahead of the flu season, we'll offer training and refresher sessions to review these changes.

Database Changes

Protocol V4.0 will bring updates to the Spinnaker database, rolling out gradually from the end of August. *More details will follow soon.*



Interventions / stock

We have no current updates on the following and we'll contact sites as soon as we have more information:

- Paediatric granules for baloxavir
